Strike Strings is a cinematic string instrument designed for instant inspiration and effortless performance. It provides powerful, pre-orchestrated string phrases and chord performances ideal for film, games, pop, and hybrid orchestral music.

Chords.nki – Chord-Based String Performances

Strike Strings - Chords.nki offers 15 customizable chord performance styles. Each preset can be shaped using **Major**, **Minor**, or **Sus4** chords via key switches. Perfect for harmonic beds and rhythmic string movements.



Minor	D1
Sus4	E1



• Playable in three distinct mix layers:

Mix Type	Key Range
Full Strings	C2 – B2
Low Strings	C3 – B3
High Strings	C4 – B4



How to Use:

- 1. Select a chord type using a key switch (C1–E1).
- 2. Play a note within C2–B4 to hear the selected style and mix.


Phrases.nki - Performance-Based String Phrases

Strike Strings - Phrases.nki delivers 17 performed string phrase styles, recorded in all keys and mapped across three mix types: Full, Low, and High. Designed for immediate cinematic results, this NKI makes it easy to explore themes and ideas without manual sequencing.

Key Features:

- 17 unique phrase styles
- · Available in all 12 keys
- Instantly playable in three mix variations:

Mix Type	Key Range
Full Strings	C2 – B2
Low Strings	C3 – B3
High Strings	C4 – B4



How to Use:

Simply play a note within the desired range (C2-B4) to trigger a phrase in that mix and key.



Both NKI instruments include two powerful knobs for real-time sound shaping:



GRIT: Adds saturation and edge to the sound, enhancing aggressiveness and power.

ightharpoonup Use this to push the strings forward in the mix, especially in action or hybrid tracks.

LFO: Applies rhythmic modulation for movement and texture.

Perfect for hybrid compositions or adding dynamic pulse to static chords.

Tips for Best Use

- Mix and Match Presets and Mixes: You can load multiple instances of Strike Strings to
 combine different presets. For example: Load Chords.nki using the Full Mix of the Forged in
 Fire preset, and another Chords.nki with the High Mix of the Rising Force preset to create a
 layered, evolving string texture.
- Explore Time Signatures: Both NKIs include presets in various time signatures 4/4, 5/4, 6/8, and 7/8 allowing you to create more rhythmic variety in your arrangements.
- Automate Controls: Use your DAW's automation tools to manipulate GRIT and LFO over time, adding motion and intensity to your track.

Strike Strings includes a massive MIDI collection! Inside the downloadable package, you'll find 744 MIDI files ready to drag and drop into your DAW. This includes:

MIDI Chords: 540 MIDI files from 15 unique chord performance styles — each available in Major, Minor, and Sus4 versions across all keys.

MIDI Phrases: 204 MIDI files from the expressive phrase performances.

Use these MIDI files with any instrument — strings, brass, woodwinds, synths — to build dynamic, customizable layers for your productions.
